Dear Madam/ Sir,

Ministry of Education's Innovation Cell, in coordination with All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) is launching 'Smart India Hackathon (SIH) 2022' involving all major technical institutions across the country. In last 5 years, SIH has evolved into world's biggest Hackathon and largest open innovation model. Moreover, Hon'ble Prime Minister has applauded SIH initiative on multiple occasions which has helped kick-start Hackathon culture in India. The previous editions of Smart India Hackathon have proven to be extremely beneficial for the students in establishing Startups and employment opportunities in various organizations.

'Smart India Hackathon 2022' will focus on both Software and Hardware approaches (similar to previous editions) to develop innovative solutions for problems and challenges from various Central Ministries/ Departments, State/UT governments, Public Sector Undertakings and industries.

We are now in the process of finalizing the problem Statements for the Smart India Hackathon 2022. I will be grateful if your State / UT identifies issues to be posted to the student community to come up with innovative (workable) solutions. In this regard, the following may kindly be considered:

1. Identify a Secretary/ HOD level officer to coordinate SIH-2022 on behalf of your State/ UT.
2. Identify 3-10 governance-related challenges/problems faced by your State/UT and allied organizations. These challenges/problem statements shall be the ones that can be solved using digital technologies (software) or hardware solutions. The problem statements may be uploaded on <https://www.sih.gov.in/> portal on or before 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2021.
3. Nominate mentors and judges for the evaluation process during SIH2022.
4. Offer prize money of Rs 1 Lakh per problem to the winning team. You may like to make arrangement for the prize money.
5. If your State/UT has already submitted problem statements for SIH-2021, (which could not be organized due to COVID pandemic), then approval to reconsider the same problems for SIH-2022 along with a letter of commitment regarding Prizes as the mentioned above is required.
6. Your commitment is required for support for further development and deployment of the winning ideas identified during the hackathon.

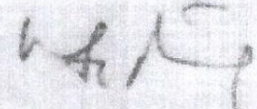
